### **FACILITIES**

## **ZERO TOLERANCE**

- Any student using alcohol, drugs, tobacco, vape, or any other substances deemed inappropriate by the PCC Students Leaders, at a Student Ministry Sanctioned Event will be dismissed immediately. Parents will be notified. The student may return to Evening Student Ministry/other events according to the established Disciplinary Policy below.

### **DISCIPLINARY POLICY**

1. First-time Offenders will receive grace and mercy. Infraction will be discussed along with the need for repentance and forgiveness with all involved parties. If restoration of relationship and change of action are achieved, there will be no further consequences. \*
2. Second-time Offenders will be asked to refrain from attendance at Student Ministry events outside of Sunday mornings for one month.
3. If the problem continues, further suspension from Student Ministry events will be enacted. (Third time= 2 Months, Fourth Time= 3 Months)
4. Severe infractions will be brought to the attention of the Church Pastors: Ray, and/or George. Further Discipline will be discussed if needed.
5. Students will always be welcome to attend on Sunday Mornings even while under suspension from evenings and extra events. Evening Student Ministry and extra activities are a privilege.

**I reserve the right to alter the Discipline found in this document depending on the infraction.**

**\*Students caught with substances against the Zero Tolerance Policy will immediately receive a two-month suspension from evening Student Ministry and Student Ministry events.**
